Dear Potential Sponsor,

In the United States, a person dies by suicide every 12.3 minutes, claiming over 48,000 lives each year. It is estimated that an attempt is made every 31 seconds; with over 1 million people attempting suicide annually. Suicide is the second leading cause of death for youth ages 10-24.

Here in Luzerne County, we are losing an average of one person per week to suicide.

The Hazleton Area High School SADD Club and *Help STOP the Silence (HSTS)*, a suicide prevention and support program based out of the Catholic Social Services Greater Hazleton office, is pleased to host the **8th Annual Help STOP the Silence - Walk to Prevent Suicide** (www.helpstopthesilence.org) on rescheduled date September 13, 2020 at the Hazleton Area High School Gymnasium. All proceeds remain local in providing services to our community. There are many “walks” in our community promoting good physical health but this is the only one promoting good mental health that will provide local services to our community.

Help STOP the Silence is currently the only local program to provide in-school student assemblies, teacher in-services, and community/workplace assemblies. These programs provide education on mental health awareness and identify at-risk behaviors to prevent suicide. Help STOP the Silence offers both peer and group support for newly bereaved individuals affected by suicide.

Many people are walking in order to raise funds and create an awareness of those individuals with mood disorders and mental health issues, which may lead to suicide. The “Walk to Prevent Suicide” also offers an opportunity for survivors to walk in memory of a loved one. My 13-year-old son, Kyle D. Koslop, fell victim to suicide in February 2007. My family, friends, and I are forever changed by this tragic event. My hope is that through education and awareness, those suffering with a mental illness will be prompted to seek help.
